## **INVITATION FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST CONSULTANCY SERVICES**

The Council is inviting expressions of interest in the form of proposals to conduct research in the following area:

- ✚ A Baseline Study to Determine the Economic Costs of Traffic Congestion in Barbados

Accordingly, submissions are hereby being sought from interested consultants and/or consulting firms with the following qualifications and expertise:

- i. Economics (linear modeling; regression; policy formulation; transportation; urban and regional economic and planning)
- ii. Engineering (civil; structural; transportation)
- iii. Public transportation estimates and planning
- iv. Feasibility studies

Individual consultants and/or consulting firms are being invited to submit information demonstrating their competence to provide the services listed above as well as an indication of their technical and educational qualifications and applicable experience (with some experience in the Caribbean region).
